



Introduction

The *Hartford Courant*, the country's oldest newspaper in continuous publication, is now searchable online and available in full text for the following years: historically **1764-1984** and currently **1992+**. Older issues (**1985-1991**) not accessible online are available on microfilm in the Babbidge Library, Microform Research Collection, Level 3. To locate those articles in the *Hartford Courant* not yet available electronically, use the print indexes described in this guide.

Microfilm and Print Indexes to the *Hartford Courant*: Babbidge Library

- 1764–1820** *Index to Connecticut News in the Connecticut Courant*
 Microfilm version of a card index compiled by the Connecticut Historical Society.
 Search the *Connecticut Courant* by names and subjects arranged alphabetically.
 Location: **Level 3, Babbidge Microform Research Collections, Microfilm**

 Compiled by Charles Towne, longtime *Courant* editor, and former instructor at the University of Connecticut.
Bound volumes are organized by broad topic; e.g., Accidents, Crime, Industry, etc. Within volumes, news items are arranged chronologically. The entry date in the *Index* refers to the date the event occurred; all events listed are reported and appear in the following day's paper.
 The **card file** is a name index, including personal and corporate names, as well as some special headings, such as musical and theatrical works. Divided into three categories (general, business, and performing arts), entries refer to the date of an event, with additional reference to the appropriate bound volume.
 See the beginning of each bound volume for detailed guidance on the use of these indexes.
Microfiche collection: contents of bound volumes in fiche format.
